



They say that things change, and for Eaglesham Fair Committee, this is no different. We've been holding on to this great news for some time now but the moment has arrived for us to announce it

No longer are we a simple community group, from now on we are an officially registered charity!

Through AOE Windfarm Limited, we've been given a fantastic opportunity that will benefit each and every resident in the Parish of Eaglesham for the foreseeable future. AOE Windfarm Limited is owned and managed by 2020 Renewables and Velocita Energy. 2020 Renewables is a dynamic company based in Greenock, Scotland. It was established in 2010 and specialises in developing, constructing and operating onshore wind projects throughout the United Kingdom. Their team have extensive knowledge in working in the renewable energy industry which dates back to 1990. Eilidh Smith is Asset Manager with the company and is heavily involved with our project. She is delighted to have been asked to judge this year's Windmill Competition. A great choice, with her being an expert, after all!

This is how it came about: AOE Windfarm Limited was seeking a local group to receive charity benefit which they were very kindly willing to donate to our community. We are delighted to say that Eaglesham Fair ticked all the boxes and we are both honoured and delighted to be entrusted with such an exciting project.

Things have gone on from there. In December 2014, Eaglesham Fair became a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (Number SC045316) in order that we could progress with the plans to manage a Community Benefit Fund and ensure we became a fully-functioning corporate body to receive payments, process requests and distribute monies to the local Community. This, in turn would also permit Eaglesham Fair to widen the scope of our remit to bring regular activities, events and funding contributions to the Village.

Each year, AOE Windfarm Limited will grant us a set amount to be distributed in and around the village. This fund will be managed and used to ensure we achieve long-term investment and growth in our local community. The provision of funding will be organised through an applications process to be managed and overseen by the Eaglesham Fair Charity Committee. This new SCIO shall invite applications from individuals, community bodies, groups, schools and similar within the parish boundaries to receive part of the allocation of the annual payments. Full details will be posted soon on our new website including specifics of the application process. The minimum amount which can be applied for is £500.

An opportunity like this can only be of benefit to Eaglesham, and we are overwhelmed with gratitude for 2020 Renewables for entrusting us with it.

Eaglesham is a unique village with a strong presence in Scotland, both old and new. With an historic past, vibrant present and prosperous future, we can only grow stronger. Us residents pride ourselves on the strong bond we share with one another. And with our defining characteristics of fairness, tolerance and intense community spirit, our presence on Scotland's map may not alter too much in size, but certainly in stature, and most certainly in reputation of being one of the most desirable and envied locations in the country to live.
